Subscription Based Garden Waste Collection Service

Potential Income

Feedback from authorities that have implemented a green waste subscription service have identified two key considerations:

- Not to under estimate administrative, financial and officer time involved with operating a chargeable service, and
- The implications of not achieving the assumed level of uptake in the service and the revenues received being lower than those budgeted

Authorities experience a significant reduction in participation when a charge is first introduced with a steady increase over time as residents realise it is easier and cheaper than disposing of the waste themselves. Pendle Council introduced a chargeable service in June 2014 and reported a 65% take up from garden properties. In addition, green waste tonnage collected showed an 18% reduction on what it had been in previous years. Based on the demographics of garden properties in Fylde it would be reasonable to assume a higher uptake, particularly if the scheme is launched at the height of the growing season, however this is difficult to predict with any degree of accuracy without public consultation to measure potential support for any scheme.
